## FROM 7 TO 11 MARCH 2022 GRAPHISTES DE L'OMBRE HOSTED THE C2, A TRANSNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE, PART OF THE "PROTECT YOURSELF" PROJECT, WHILE FROM 3 TO 7 MAY IT WAS THE TURN OF KREATEAM, WHICH HOSTED THE C3.

The partners of the Erasmus + "Protect Yourself" project continue their work incessantly to achieve the objectives originally set.

In fact, in recent months, two other transnational training courses have been held (C2 and C3), the first in France, Marseille and the second in Eger, Hungary which had as their objective that of sharing and joint learning by all participants.

Other objectives of these training courses were:

- Consolidate partner skills by adding non-formal sessions to improve critical thinking skills of adults through workshops,
- Help adult educators develop their soft skills: teamwork and communication.

During the C2 Activity in Marseille in France the participants from Italy, Spain, Hungary, Romania and France, learned and shared through workshops how to fight climate change.

During all three days, each organization was able to carry out some guide tests, to understand precisely if the workshops chosen to be included in the manual that will contain all these activities are effective, what are the difficulties in putting them into practice, which are learning objectives and strengths. During the C3 in Eger in Hungary, on the other hand, the participants, always coming from all 5 countries of the consortium, met to complete the guide tests on the latest activities produced and included in the magazine. The topics covered were many and varied, we went from the creation of an advertising campaign to combat climate change, to the creation of an interactive game that could leave notions, up to the identification in a city completely without energy and having to solve the vital problems that in that case would arise before us and finally we tried to imagine how concretely within a city we can work to reduce waste and therefore make it more sustainable.
